
LTD's Monthly Meeting, Winter Holiday Party, and Winter Solstice Ritual

Group Marriage/Group Living SF Samples: Robert A. Heinlein (Future History), Spider Robinson (Callahan books) & S. M. Sterling's Novels of the Change

Robert A. Heinlein's stories offer us multi-generational group marriage in <u>The Moon is a Harsh Mistress</u>, and everything from open marriage practiced by utterly committed couples to a group marriage spanning not only wide age ranges, but multiple alternate universes in <u>Time Enough for Love</u>, <u>The Number of the Beast</u>, and <u>To Sail Beyond the Sunset</u>.

Spider Robinson's Callahan's Crosstime Saloon books give us open marriages practiced by sexual "Artists" along with what amounts to group living in a very inclusive Brothel engaged in high level diplomacy affecting History. The customers of Callahan's Place form a group of people whose lives connect on MANY levels, affecting all the relationships in their lives and ultimately leading them all into a trek cross country to the Florida Keys to continue their very intertwined lives together.

His <u>Stardance</u> novels offer group marriage in Space spanning Time and including gay, bi and hetero members.



S. M. Stirling's Emberverse series (aka Novels of the Change) give us several examples of group living. Some groups live in Castles and Forts with Medieval trappings, while others live open fields, farms and gardens in a more Pagan practice, with a central Home serving meals and holiday feasts. These cultural approaches re based on historical examples, with adaptations due to being carried out by humans in our present time (but without our present technology).

Paul and Terry did Live the Dream presentations at the <u>Lifestyles Convention</u> for several years, and also led *Evening of Caressive Intimacy*, one of that convention's main events. 
#### The Lazarus Llllooonnnggg Series by Robert Heinlein

The following books by Robert A. Heinlein are part of his future history series:

Methuselah's Children
Time Enough for Love
The Number of the Beast
The Cat Who Walks Through Walls
To Sail Beyond the Sunset
The Notebooks of Lazarus Long









What do these books have in common? They all have <u>Lazarus Long</u> (born Woodrow Wilson Smith), the oldest living Human. <u>The Moon is a Harsh Mistress</u> and <u>Stranger in a Strange Land</u> did not have him. They were actually written before these others but were brought back into the mix later.

Heinlein manages to tie all these story lines together in a montage that starts one thinking of plates of spaghetti. He created several distinctly different timelines in his stories. Yet, he managed to have a recurrent theme dominating many of them: **Love**.

How many ways can a person love? How many people can one person love? Is love fated to fade away? How many people can you love at one time?

After raising all these questions, Heinlein teaches us that:

- 1) We cannot love enough.
- 2) There is no limit to the number of people you can love--except the limit you place on yourself.
- 3) Love is what makes life worth living.

Heinlein makes each of these books entertaining on its own, but even more meaningful when read in order. Characterization is at least as important as plot.

In <u>The Number of the Beast</u>, Heinlein introduces a concept which enables his characters to travel to not only to alternate timelines he himself created in previous novels, but to alternate realities consisting of the universes created by other authors – from the <u>Land of Oz</u> to the <u>Lensman series</u>. The idea is that if sufficient numbers of people have read about it, their minds create it. This means that Lazarus can jump timelines to go recruiting for worthwhile members for his expanded family, who just happen to be the protagonists of Heinlein's previous stories. This is where <u>Stranger in a Strange Land</u> and <u>The Moon is a Harsh Mistress</u> reintegrate with his unique future history.

Heinlein uses a lot of artistic freedom to provide everything his characters need in order to make their massive family work: lives that last hundreds of years, plenty of money, and ways to take a vacation from each other on other planets and in other histories. However, the ways the people actually relate to each other is real and human.

Heinlein's trademark has always been to keep his characters believable. A saloon owner who is the subject of an Emperor of Nine Worlds is smuggling a runaway slave off planet. What is she concerned about as she returns home with mission completed? Keeping her customers satisfied and her business profitable. (*Citizen of the Galaxy*).

If you want to see graphic descriptions of what an ideal group marriage/expanded family would operate like, from who watches the kids to who engenders them and how they keep track of it, from how the house is set up architecturally to the wording of marriage ceremonies for bringing in new members, read some of these stories. Those who really live these life styles have gleaned much practical advise that really works from this stuff.

Between the numerous scenes detailing familial bliss, you can learn scores of Heinlein's Life Lessons, disguised as Lazarus' words of wisdom as compiled by the historian of the <u>Howard families</u>, Justin Foote. This is a kinship line bred for long life of which Lazarus is the Senior member. They discover that monogamy doesn't work too well in a situation requiring it be honored over very Illooonnnggg lives and that the plural of spouse is definitely spice...



**November 11, 2022 was the official launch date for** *Fifty Years of Polyamory in America: A Guided Tour of a Growing Movement,* by Glen Olson and Terry Brussel-Rogers, published by Rowman and Littlefield. It is a fascinating read, and is being used in academic research papers on the subject. Between them, Terry and Glen have experience with open marriage, group marriage, and group living, and both are part of an intimate network which has evolved from 1969 to present time.

Fifty Years of Polyamory in America: A Guided Tour to a Growing Movement is unique among the many books about polyamory because the scope of this book

is the entire history of the polyamory movement, from Woodstock right on into the 21<sup>st</sup> century. The book is available at <u>Amazon</u>, <u>Barnes and Noble</u>, and many other places — even internationally! -- just by <u>Googling its title</u>.

The publishers are continuing to put this book in more and more universities and libraries! Students are using material from it in Masters theses and Doctoral dissertations on Polyamory!
