Elain, a trans/bi/poly lady is living this lifestyle full time (as opposed to male at work and female in her personal life) since 2017. Many years before that, she experienced being a husband and father in a traditional monogamous marriage. Even then, she was aware of a pull towards being a woman. She will share her own journey and what she has observed of polyamory along the way. Terry and Rodney have lived the poly lifestyle all their adult lives. Rodney is a bi male who has been in an open committed relationship with his partner Mark Merlino for over 32 years. They are the recognized founders of Furry Fandom (see their story in the excellent documentary "The Movement") and have had a group house for most of their time together through to the present. Terry is a bi poly woman who raised her children in an open marriage, was in residential triads and is now in an open committed relationship with her husband Craig Brussel Rogers. They live in a group house. She has led workshops on bisexuality at lifestyles and Loving More conferences for many years and watched bisexuality become more and more acceptable in the poly community among both men and women. She will share some of those experiences. Do you have experiences you would like to share or just questions to ask? Come grow with us!

Saturday May 22 2022 11 am to 12:30 pm on Zoom. Moon is a Harsh Mistress & Multi Generational (Line) Marriage The setting is a Lunar prison colony with men way out numbering the women. Triads (two men, one woman), gangs of young men lead by one woman and multi-generational (Line) group marriages are among the ways they deal with this shortage. Add a revolution for freedom from the unreasonable restrictions of the Warden and the Earth he represents. One of the leaders of this revolution is also a member of a Line Marriage. Another is a man with some unusual ideas on the meaning of Liberty and still another a Lady who stirs the crowd to Action, joins this new fight for Freedom and marries into the Line Marriage. We'll have a good look at how such a marriage works, what is involved in marrying six adults and adopting children already in the group.

Bisexual Love In a Long Term Relationship by Terry Brussel-Gibbons (2001)

Vick is in town! He meets me for lunch with his wife of two years, Helga, who is flying back to their home in Europe today. (Names changed to protect the nervous). They sit on one side of a table with me on the other--I resolve not to let it upset me. We talk about the shamanic studies they've been pursuing in Phoenix, Helga's enjoyment of our warm weather, exciting developments in my business, and how our grown kids are doing. While Helga and I have spent time together before, she seems more open and accepting this time. Before leaving, she gives me a soapstone dolphin she has made--a special gift.

Vick drives her to LAX, sees her off, and picks me up to spend the weekend together. We stop by my house to pick up my overnight bag and to give hugs and affection to my husband, Paul. We arrange to spend tomorrow evening with him. Paul walks his talk about open relationships--no jealousy there, never a trace of coldness when I return from time with a lover. Paul is the treasure of my life and I make sure he knows it.

Vick takes me for a romantic dinner on the coast. We look at the ocean, hold hands, and catch up on each other's inner worlds. The magic is still THERE--in a touch, a smile. Pretty good after 20 years of ups, downs and too much physical apartness for the past few years.

We van camp at a local beach, too tired to make it to Santa Barbara tonight. Not too tired for lovin'--deep, passionate explosion of God and Goddess joining in ecstasy.

Next day we eat our breakfast of fruit on a cliff overlooking the sea, have lunch in Solvang and find time for more lovemaking. He's really been immersing himself in teachings of Sacred Sexuality and seems to have more vitality in bed and out than he did ten years ago. Lucky Helga!

On our way home, we plot to reward Paul for handling the Live the Dream meeting today and giving us some special time together. After a light dinner of tuna salad and juice, we head for the bedroom.

Paul thinks he and Vick are going to drive me wild, but (surprise) it's Paul's turn to be in the middle. We touch, pet, and stroke him from head to foot. I love watching the two of them cuddling and loving each other. That probably drives me wilder than when they work on me! It used to be in my "secret garden" of fantasy only, but how delicious the reality. Paul delights in watching me with another woman, too. His joy heightens my own.

A woman looking over my shoulder as I write this while waiting for my chiropractic appointment, said "You have a great imagination, but it might be just too farfetched even for fiction."

For a bisexual polyamorous couple, reality can be a lot better than fantasy!

My belief that Bi is Better remains firm in the present. I even marched in the Gay Pride a few years ago with a Bi group and was the one with the megaphone announcing "We are the B in LGBT!"

The lady presenting with me in our April meeting is also my lover and is Family by Choice due to Water Shared (see Stranger in a Strange Land).. I am extremely grateful for her caring support and physical presence as I deal with the loneliness and emotional upheaval of my husband's health condition and his being in the hospital much of the time.

Being bi is especially valuable in the poly community as it allows for closer relationships between same sex members of triads and group marriages as well as more inclusive dating even if the participants are not living together. Throughout our fifteen-year marriage, Paul and I preferred bisexual partners both of us could enjoy in bed and out. We still feel that way. I am glad he and Craig have chosen to be close.

I have always believed that for a bisexual person to be completely fulfilled, they would have to be poly since only that way could they have both a man and woman in their love lives. Not everyone agrees with me on this. Some bisexual people pick a life mate of one sex or the other and choose to be monogamous with that person. Some of them even "pass" as gay or hetero depending on which sex their partner is and which community, they are participating in. It's all about personal choice and each individual gets to pick who and how many they get to Love.

Fifty Years of Polyamory in America: A Guided Tour to a Growing Movement is unique among the many books about polyamory because the scope of this book is the entire history of the polyamory movement. Instead of concentrating on the experiences of a few people exploring alternate lifestyles, it is an exploration of two generations of Americans, the people and the organizations they founded, what they have chosen to do, and how it has changed their lives and affected the culture as a whole.

Written in an entertaining and easily accessible style, the authors cover the history of alternative sexual relationship styles starting with a quick peek at colonial times, the Mormon and Oneida movements of the 1840s-70s, and modern-day influences starting in the 1950s.

Polyamory, literally "many loves," challenges the relationship norm: monogamy. As its name suggests, polyamory typically refers to emotional/sexual relationships that include multiple partners. Common applications of polyamory include open marriages, triad (three people), two-couple (four people) "marriages," and larger groups like intimate networks. Swingers are a subset of non-monogamy who often identify as poly.

Throughout the course of *Fifty Years of Polyamory in America*, we explore the history of the polyamory movement: from clinical definitions and attempts at psychiatric treatment, to the advent of advocacy groups in the 1960s and '70s, to contemporary practitioners and the future of the movement. A wide range of personal stories from advocates and practitioners guides the narrative to the modern day, highlighting the struggles and successes of the movement throughout the years.
