

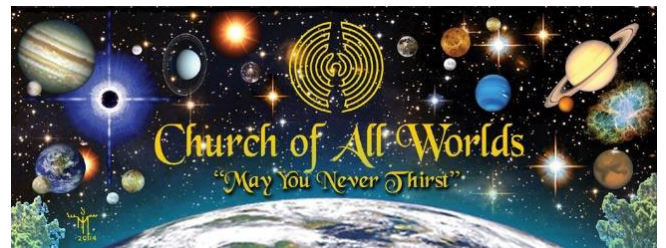

When I (Terry) first heard the term Pansexual, I thought it was just a fancy name for Bisexual. Apparently not. That term refers to people who are attracted to both men and women, possibly only those born male or female and still identifying as such. Pansexual means for some that they are open to sexual relationships with anyone whom they feel a connection to, regardless of whether they identify as male, female, pre-op or post-op transsexuals, non-binary or even asexual. Each of these possibilities is just one more way of expressing the Being (or Spirit) within. Elaine and Matt will share their own experiences and what they have observed in their dating and long-term poly partnership experiences. All the Shades of Polyamory and What We Call Them

The way we describe things helps clarify them in our own minds...also new ways of describing what we have been doing for many years means we must learn those new terms to communicate clearly with those who are in our lives. For me, this includes leading meetings on the subject of polyamory during which I must make my meanings match the current terms. Elaine has helped me to do that.

Elaine is a trans pansexual lady, living that lifestyle full time since 2017. Many years before that, she experienced being a husband and father in a traditional monogamous marriage. She will share her own journey and what she has observed of polyamory along the way. She has in her life a cis female lover, a trans female lover and two cis male lovers, including Matt, who also is pansexual. Matt has

in his life now a cis female primary partner, a cis female lover, and 2 trans female lovers. Both Elaine and Matt manage to make time graciously for all those they love and care about in their lives including their grown children.

Elaine came into my life when my husband had cancer and was frequently in the hospital for at least 12-15 days a month in chemo, urgent care etc. She was really *There* for me while this was going on, giving me loving support though she lived an hour and a half away in Lancaster. She helped me with the tech aspects of doing Live the Dream meetings on Zoom, helped me set up for the in-person part of those meetings, and stayed over as frequently as both our schedules permitted, sleeping in my bed whether my husband was there too or not. While I knew I was bi and had had close sexual loving relationships with women in my life before, some of whom were trans and very dear to me, this was the first one which really did not include a man as part of the relationship. Even when my husband was home, their relationship was and still is strictly platonic.

Elaine and I became water kin (family by choice Stranger in a Strange Land style) early in our relationship and have continued to Grow Closer in many ways since then. We can go out for an evening together, snuggle while riding the Ferris wheel at Venice Beach, or have lunch with her daughter or mine. She continues to be a joy in my life.

I learned the term Kitchen Table Polyamory from Elaine. I guess it is what I have been practicing much of my adult life. I learned after my first marriage (poly, but complicated) that it did not work for me to have lovers who could not form at least a close friendship with my primary partner (or husband when I had one). They were welcome to join us for dinner, holidays and birthdays. My second husband, Paul, whom I was married to for 15 years, is now married to Athena, while I am married to Craig. We go beyond kitchen table polyamory by sharing vacations as well as dinners, holidays and birthdays. We all sleep in one BIG bed when they travel from Phoenix to visit us at our home for a night, a week, or more.

I had a conversation with someone attending the first Saturday Poly Meetup in Burbank last month. He had realized recently that he had been Poly for years. He was negotiating with someone he was dating as to whether their relationship should be Kitchen Table or if his outside relationships should be entirely separate from her. Something about the way he spoke of it told me that having his lovers be part of each other's lives in some way was really as important to him as it was to me. I advised him not to let himself be cheated out of the joy that would bring him, particularly since he was not living with or married to the person requesting that. Even if he had been, this may have been the right time to assert himself.

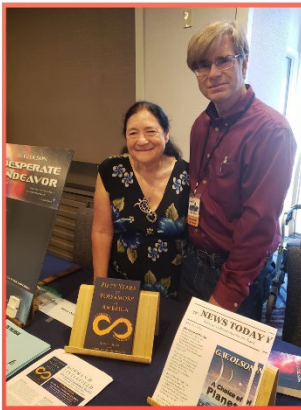
It is important to set boundaries and know what is non-negotiable for you in any relationship, poly or monogamous. This is best done before the relationship becomes serious. I have learned that fact through many years of living the lifestyle, doing poly relationship coaching, poly as well as monogamous matchmaking, and hypnotherapy.

Elaine has helped me to better define my poly terms and therefore my values even though her experience in the lifestyle is not nearly as long as my own. So has Matt, dear to me in his own way. May all of you benefit from the wisdom they share with you during this meeting!

I am glad Elaine and Matt are available to do our May meeting while Paul, Athena, Craig and I attend Oberon Zell's wedding to his Lady Rhiannon in Tennessee that weekend. I am handling the guestbook for the wedding. Oberon credits me with helping him make the list which helped him realize Rhiannon was the partner he had sought since his wife Morning Glory's passing (on May 13, 2014, after 35 years of joyous marriage). Oberon is the founder of Church of All Worlds, which Morning Glory helped him lead during their years together. She is the one who coined the word Polyamory in the 90s. Rhiannon is a Pagan community leader herself and Oberon's perfect match in so many ways. He proposed to her in a shower of fireworks on the 4th of July, 2023. They are being married May 17, 2024!

November 11, 2022 was the official launch date for *Fifty Years of Polyamory in America: A Guided Tour of a Growing Movement*, by Glen Olson and Terry Brussel-Rogers, published by Rowman and Littlefield. It is a fascinating read, and is being used in academic research papers on the subject. Between them, Terry and Glen have experience with open marriage, group marriage, and group living, and both are part of an intimate network which has evolved from 1969 to present time.

Fifty Years of Polyamory in America: A Guided Tour to a Growing Movement is unique among the many books about polyamory because the scope of this book is the entire history of the polyamory movement, from Woodstock right on into the 21st century. The book is available on Amazon, Barnes and Noble, and many other places—even internationally! -- just by Googling its title.

The publishers are continuing to put this book in more and more universities and libraries! Students are starting to use material from it in Masters theses and Doctoral dissertations on Polyamory.

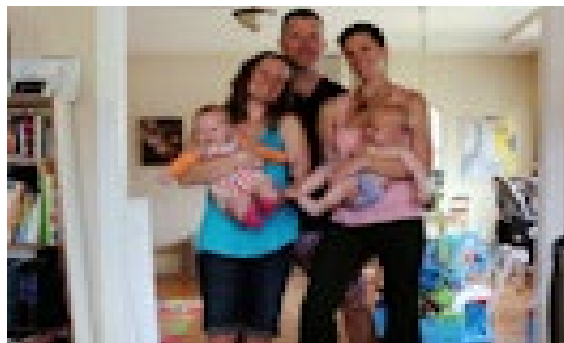
